Sustainable Environment Commitment Statement

At Cosella Dörken we believe it is our duty and responsibility to protect the environment we live in. Building green involves the business of manufacturing. At Cosella Dörken we do not manufacture products or by-products which can negatively impact our world. We are very sensitive to protecting our environment and the people who are in our employ, while producing high quality, sustainable products that will create healthier living environments.

We develop products that:

- are non-toxic, emit ZERO volatile compounds (VOC)
- are produced in North America by fair market wage employees
- utilize high quality recycled and remanufactured ingredients
- are low transportable cost products
- have low impact on environmental resources
- are non-polluting
- are safe to handle and install
- are fully recyclable
- are sustainable minimum 50 years service life

We process High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) to make products such as DELTA®-DRY, DELTA®-DRAIN and DELTA®-MS. This process uses only hydrogen and carbon where there are basically zero emissions. We recycle our scrap material from our production and also purchase selected recycled HDPE.

Cosella Dörken's manufacturing process is clean, allowing us to recycle the heat produced by the machinery. Our manufacturing facility uses heat exchangers to capture heat from the area above the machinery which is reused in the heating of our facility. We have invested in power failure correction switches, and low harmonic distortion filters for improved efficiency in motors. We utilize motion switches, low energy idling devices and outdoor storage to save energy. We also utilize natural daylight, high efficiency electrical lighting and water saving fixtures. We use recycled paper and environmentally friendly inks.

Our parent company Dörken is EMAS (Eco-Management and Audit Scheme) certified. Cosella Dörken located in Beamsville, Ontario, Canada, utilizes an identical production process. We manufacture cleanly and do not negatively impact the world we live in. This provides a safe and pleasant place to work.



DELTA®-DRAIN and DELTA®-MS are both below grade drainage/ foundation waterproofing materials. They are manufactured with approximately 60% selected recycled HDPE. The recycled core materials are encased in virgin HDPE polymers to create a product that is sustainable and durable. We utilize a unique technology to ensure sustainable long term quality in excess of 50 years. This is our strong commitment to sustainability. Our products function for a lifetime – they do not require constant replacement. If they are replaced they can be 100% recycled. We utilize recyclable, biodegradable and minimal packaging for all our products.

Cosella Dörken manufactures materials that protect building enclosures from moisture problems. Our products do not require existing or ongoing conditions to be just right for long term performance to prevail. The products perform directly with the physics of fluid flow to provide a service function that works every day and for decades without adding additional energy for their performance other than the initial energy it took to manufacture and apply the materials.

We are an active participant in CIPEC (Canadian Industry Program for Energy Conservation), USGBC (US Green Building Council), EEBA, CHBA, NAHB and Southface.
